Who is Rupert Gordon? Rupert Gordon was appointed as the Assistant Deputy Minister of the Community Services Division at the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services in August of 2017. In this role, Rupert leads the policy and operational oversight of services for vulnerable adults including developmental services in the province. Prior to his role, Rupert was the Director of the Poverty Reduction Strategy Office, focusing on alignment and public reporting on the Poverty Reduction Strategy's initiatives, and the Director of the Early Years Policy and Programs Branch at the Ministry of Education, working on the roll-out of Full Day Kindergarten and the modernization of childcare and family support programs.

Rupert has also worked in a number of other roles in the Ontario Public Service at Cabinet Office and the Ministries of Municipal Affairs and Housing, Public Infrastructure Renewal, Finance and Intergovernmental Affairs.

Rupert has an undergraduate degree in Political Science and Mass Communication from Carleton University and three graduate degrees in Political Science, including a Ph.D., from Yale University.
